Late Starts

Late starts cannot be facilitated at our District. Successful applicants are required to commence work at the start of the training year in January.

Vocational Training

- South Canterbury is currently accredited in Rural Hospital Emergency Medicine Training and can offer 6-month placements.
- South Canterbury can also offer 6-month placements towards Obstetrics & Gynaecology diploma, and Paediatric diploma in Child Health.

Regular House Officer Teaching

House Officers have 2 hours protected teaching time per week.

Rosters

Rosters vary across the specialties however to give you an idea:

PGY1 – Quarter 1-Quarter 2

- Long Days Approximately 1:9
- Weekends Approximately 1:4

PGY1 – Quarter 3-Quarter 4

- Long Days Approximately 1:13
- Nights Approximately 1:4
- Weekends Approximately 1:7

PGY1 Average Pay

Depends on Single Employer Collective Agreement (SECA)
