## Background

## Advanced Choice of Employment

ACE is a centralised application and matching process which allows medical school graduates throughout the country to submit one application which is then distributed to up to 20 Districts around the country.

The ACE RMO process has been in place since 2003 and is also used to support the recruitment of Registered Nursing graduates since 2012 and Enrolled Nursing graduates since 2020.

The ACE process is the most effective way to gain a first year House Officer (PGY1) position starting in January 2026.



# ACE Principles

All Districts have agreed to implement the ACE process to employ graduates to their first year House Officer positions

All graduates seeking first year House Officer positions must apply via the ACE process An applicants District preference rankings are private and confidential

Neither party in the recruitment process are permitted to make independent contracts prior to the notification of match results

Once matched to a District, there is an expectation that applicants will accept a position with that hospital No Match Swaps

Districts may not appoint
House Officers matched to
another hospital without the
express consent of that
hospital and ACE

Any applicant who declines an offer made through the ACE process will be excluded from that ACE intake, including the talent pool

## ACE Process Overview













Submit application to ACE

ACE assess applications and sends to preferred districts

Districts review, rank, and interview applicants ACE completes national match and notify districts and applicants

Districts offer matched applicants directly Applicants accept or decline offer from district






# Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to apply through ACE for a first year House Officer position applicants must meet one of the following eligibility criteria:

- Category One: Graduates from New Zealand medical schools and are citizens or permanent residents of New Zealand or Australia.
- Category Two: Graduates from Australian medical schools and are citizens or permanent residents of New Zealand or Australia.
- Category Three: Graduates from New Zealand medical schools and are not permanent residents of New Zealand or Australia.

# Employer Preferences

Applicants can select up to 20 Districts as part of their employer preferences

A minimum of 6 Districts must be selected for a complete application

ACE recommends selecting at least 10 Districts



Be prepared to rank Districts outside the major centres and be prepared to move as there may be more applicants than positions available



## Required ID Documents

New Zealand Citizens: The photo page of New Zealand Passport plus either a New Zealand Tertiary Student Identification Card or New Zealand Driver Licence.

For New Zealand Citizens in lieu of a New Zealand Passport, ACE will accept a **New Zealand Citizenship Certificate** or **New Zealand Full Birth Certificate** that is issued on or after 1 January 1998 and that carries a unique identification number.

Australian Citizens: The photo page of Australian Passport plus either a New Zealand Tertiary Student Identification Card or New Zealand Driver Licence.

Permanent Resident Visa or Resident Visa Holders: The photo page of an Overseas Passport plus the relevant Visa Document plus either a New Zealand Tertiary Student Identification Card or New Zealand Driver Licence.



## Required Documents



### **Academic Transcripts**

These must be certified if you are uploading these yourself

You must sign a consent to release form from your Med School. **ACE does not receive this itinerary** from the Med Schools.

**DO NOT upload your consent to release form** in place of your Academic Transcript

All applicants who sign a consent to release transcripts to ACE must start their application prior to the registration cut off date, 21 June 2025

Failure to do so will confer on you, responsibility to upload a certified unofficial transcript yourselves



3 completed references from core placements in Y6.

Referees MUST have vocational scope of practice in the area of specialty which you are being supervised.

## Optional Documents

Cover Letter(s): **Highly recommended** that you write individual Cover Letters for each employer that you preference

- Deans Commendations and Clinical Results: Year 4 and 5
- Prizes, Scholarships & Presentations
- Medical publications
- 📦 📄 Any degrees other than your medical degree

You will be asked to provide proof of awards, publications and any additional qualification by uploading a copy of your certificate or confirmation letter in the documents section.



# References

- ➤ Applicants are required to provide **3 references** from supervising clinicians from their final (6<sup>th</sup>) year.
- A referee must be an **SMO** who is **vocationally registered** in their area of practice or a General Practitioner
- ACE will allow the following exceptions for applicants that are on elective overseas during the first half of their TI year:
- One reference from your elective, provided:

The hospital you completed an elective in is in a comparable health country, or


The clinical supervisor providing a reference for an elective completed in a non-comparable health country possesses a current practising certificate and has vocational scope of practice with either the New Zealand Medical Council, Australian Medical Council, General Medical Council (GMC) or Irish Medical Councils.

**OR** 

One reference from a placement completed in the second half of your 5<sup>th</sup> year




## ACE RMO Reference Flowchart

You must provide ACE with three references from your final year, exceptions to this are outlined in the ACE Business Rules.

All references must be requested and completed using the 'Your References' tab in the top left corner. 'Your References' is set up as a reference library, separate to this application form, and contains the reference policy and detailed instructions on requesting references. Instructions on how to request ACE to upload manually completed reference forms are also included.

Once a reference form has been completed by your referee, you will need to attach each reference to this application form by using the drop down box below. Pending references cannot be attached to the application form and will require further follow up from you, to ensure that your referees complete your references well before applications close.

Please note that if a manual reference file upload request has been sent to ACE, it will display as complete so that it can be attached to your application using the drop down box below. ACE will not be able to upload the manual reference file until the manual reference is chosen from the drop down box and added to the application below. Once the manual reference is added below, it will display the following message 'Incomplete - Awaiting File', until ACE has uploaded your manual reference file. Please get in contact with the ACE team if you are unsure whether your reference has been received, as your application status will remain incomplete if no



# Paired Applicants

To apply as a pair, both applicants must:	Key things to remember:			
Detail their wish to apply as paired applicants on the online ACE application form in the Personal Details section . To do this you will need the applicant number of the other applicant you wish to pair with	The ACE algorithm will consider the pair based on the lowest eligibility category of the two applicants			
Detail in cover letter(s) that you want to apply as a paired applicant so employers can identify your reasons for this	The ACE algorithm will consider the pair based on the lowest District ranking of the two applicants			
Make sure your District preferences are identical (i.e. Preference the same number of employers in the same order) – if your preferences are different ACE will not be able to pair your application in the system and you will not be put through the ACE Match process as a pair.	A match can only be facilitated where there are two House Officer positions still available at the time the algorithm considers the paired applicants.



## **Match Process**







District ranking and applicant preferences audited

Electronic match is run Electronic match results audited Unmatched applicants and districts with vacancies contacted

Applicants and districts consider additional preferences

Manual match process is run



# Matching Algorithm Process

### **Algorithms Principles**

- 1. Applicant's DHB Preference (highest priority)
- 2. District Ranking of Applicants (second priority)
  - 3. One Match per Applicant

## Begins with Category 1 Applicants

(NZ Graduates and NZ/AUS Citizens or Permanent Residents)

#### **Selects First District**

Algorithm starts at top of District's ranked applicant list

#### **Match by First Preference**

- Checks if each applicant ranked this District as their 1st preference
- If yes → matches applicant to District
- If no → moves to next ranked applicant

#### **Remove Matched Applicants**

Once an applicant is matched to their 1st preference, they are removed from all other district lists

## Continue Matching by Preferences

After all possible first preference matches are complete

- → Algorithm repeats the process for 2nd preference
  - → Continues until lowest preference is reached

### The process continues until:

All District positions are filled, **or**All Category 1 applicants have been processed.

#### Move to next Category

- → Once Category 1 matching is complete and positions still available
- → Algorithm repeats the process for Category 2, then Category 3 applicants







Districts & applicants notified of match outcome late August or early September 2025



Districts send offers directly to successful applicants Early - mid September 2025



Unmatched applicants automatically go into the Talent Pool
The Talent Pool is available to all Districts to fill any subsequent
positions that arise during the year.



Unmatched applicants can contact any Districts they are interested in working with directly to indicate their interest, and should keep an eye on District's Career websites & Health New Zealand | Te Whatu Ora RMO careers page



You have four months to complete your application. Don't leave it to the last minute

There may be more applicants than jobs so if your application is late there will be no exceptions

It is your responsibility to make sure your application is complete

Log in to your application and make sure your transcript is uploaded, make sure your referees have responded

This is a job application and there are no extensions

Do your research

Be prepared to move

# ACE RMO 2025 Match Results

## 98.21% of the available 560 positions included in the process have been filled through the match process.

550 out of 558 (98.56%) applicants have been matched to a position.


8 unmatched applicants automatically entered the national talent pool. 1 of those applicants withdrew from the intake.

National offers went out to all 550 matched applicants.

6 applicants received offers while in the talent pool. 1 withdrew and 1 remains in the talent pool.

Overall, 556 (99.64%) of all applicants have been offered PGY 1 roles


