Late Starts

Late starts cannot be facilitated at our DHB. Successful applicants are required to commence work at the start of the training year in January.

Vocational Training

- Rural Hospital Medicine Training
- Basic Surgical Training (Dept. RACS accredited)
- Basic and Advanced RACP Physician Training (Dept. RACP accredited)
- Advanced Paediatric Training Post (RACP accredited)

Regular House Officer Teaching

- Weekly Protected PGY1 HO Teaching (1hr)
- Weekly Protected PGY2 HO Teaching (1 hr). Can also include Dept. Registrar teaching
- Weekly Grand Rounds
- Departmental Teaching (journal clubs, department grand rounds etc. and daily one-on-one teaching)

Rosters

Rosters vary across the specialities however to give you an idea on average you will work:

- Safe Hours Rostering – No nights at all in 1st year (at this stage)
- 10 days on and 4 days off (when working weekends)
- PGY1 Roster 2.5 weekends and 11 evening shifts (per HO quarter at this stage)
