

ACE RMO 2019 Intake Timeline

February 2019	ACE information made available on ACE Website
Monday 11 February 2019, 9 am	Applications open on ACE website Application process for 2019 intake opens to allow students to start applying online. Applicants can register and create a profile for within ACE prior to this.
Thursday 7 - Friday 15 March 2019	ACE and Employer Roadshow ACE and Employer Roadshow will take place over two weeks in the beginning of March. Week 1: 7 th March Auckland, 8 th March Hamilton Week 2: 13 th March Christchurch, 14 th March Dunedin, 15 th March Wellington
Friday 24 May 2019	Applicant Registration cut off Applicants should have begun their application and sent three reference requests prior to this time to allow time for referees to respond.
Friday 7 June 2019, 12:00 noon (NZT)	Applications Close Applications are open for 3.5 months. Once applications have closed applicants' documentation is checked and made available in the database for viewing and/or downloading by the employers.
Monday 17 June 2019, 5pm	All completed applications sent to the employers (DHBs) ACE assesses all applicants to ensure they meet eligibility criteria and then score them on a set of nationally agreed criteria. Once this process has been complete ACE releases applications to employers for selection and ranking.
Tuesday 18 June 2019	Ranking process starts Employers have 3 weeks to make their selections to hire and submit these to ACE.
Wednesday 10 July 2019, 12 noon	Employers submit their final number of PGY1 positions and their ranked applicants to ACE Employers log-in to ACE and input their rankings in order of preference and their final number of graduates to be hired.
Wednesday 10 - Friday 12 July 2019	Part 1 of Match and Audit Completed ACE runs match and audits results before compiling matched applicant spreadsheets for each employer
Friday 12 - Monday 15 July 2019	Employers with vacancies and unmatched category one applicants are contacted by ACE ACE will contact all employers with remaining vacancies and request they rank any unmatched category 1 applicants. They will then also contact any unmatched category 1 applicants and request they preference any employers with remaining vacancies.
Monday 22 July 2019, 12 noon	Employers and applicants return additional ranked options Employers and category 1 applicants who have been asked to rank additional options will need to return their rankings by 12pm.
Thursday 25 July 2019, by 5pm	Match results sent to employers ACE has 4 days to perform the final manual match and compile spreadsheets to send to employers by 5pm.
Monday 29 July 2019, by 5pm	ACE release results to all applicants ACE notifies all applicants of the outcome of their application via email.
Monday 5 August 2019	Employers release formal offers to applicants Employers will complete any pre-offer Vulnerable Children Safety checks required before releasing official offers to matched candidates. <i>All matched graduates must be offered to on this nationally agreed date, unless there are exceptional circumstances.</i>
Tuesday 6 August 2019	ACE sends Talent Pool to Employers ACE prepares the Talent Pool and makes it available for the DHBs nationwide. Unsuccessful applicants will need to approach employers directly regarding any remaining vacancies.
Monday 12 August 2019	Successfully matched graduates respond to offers Successful graduates have 1 week to accept or reject offers by responding directly to their matched employer.
Wednesday 14 August 2019	Employers advise ACE of match offer and acceptance outcomes Employers advise ACE of acceptances or declines.
